Key:

- ① Finger number & placement on string
- x Do not play this string
- Open string - play string with no fingers
-  Place finger flat across (barre) the strings

Guitar Chords

How to read guitar chord diagrams:

The name of the chord.

A small 'm' indicates a minor chord, e.g. 'Am'

'X' means do not play this string

'O' indicates an 'open' string (play the string with no fingers on this string)

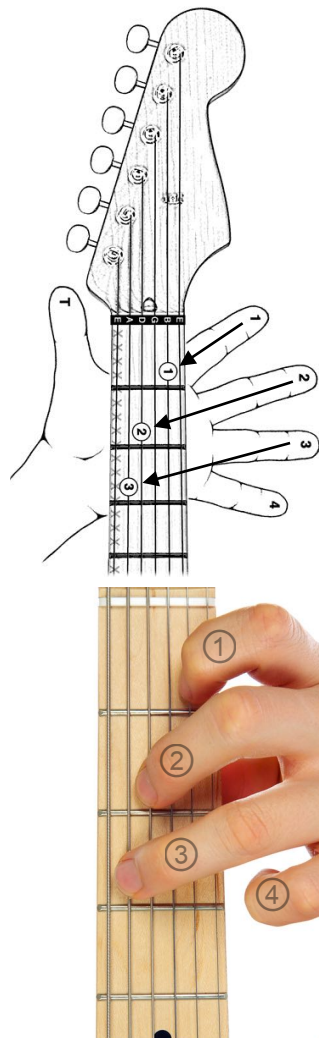
The 'nut'; indicates the top of the fretboard

These circled numbers tell you which finger of your left hand to use and which fret/string to place that finger on.

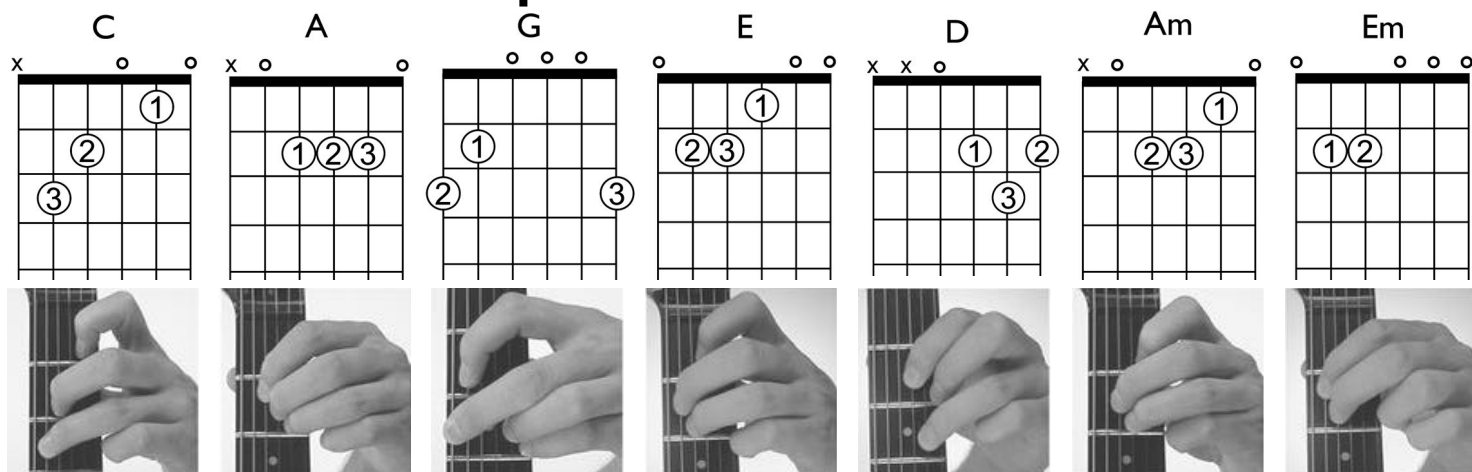


The string closest to your chin
